



## CHÂTEAU DE VAUGELAS

Corbières Le Prieuré 2008

Reintroducing Château de Vaugelas. Almost entirely one block, this vast vineyard (120 hectares) runs along the dry terrace of the Orbieu River, its long rows of vines perfectly trained in Cordon de Royat—a trellis system introduced by Jérôme Bonfils (one of three Bonfils sons) and maintained by oenologist Christian Lacassy. Adding to a series of remarkable bottlings, this cuvée, which recalls the monastic origin of the domaine, gains a star compared to the previous vintage. It is an assemblage of Syrah (40%), Grenache and Carignan. It has a deep robe, almost black with purplish reflections, its nose intense and complex combining ripe fruits, minerality and menthol nuances. Its round, balanced and elegant mouth forms a wine that is at the same time dense and supple, which merits high praise.
